

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

All Little Honey wood burners are baked at 200°C for 30mins to harden paint when manufactured.

The first lighting of the fire will cause further fuming as the temperature increases past 200°C for the first time. Burn the Little Honey for 4 hrs on high. It is recommended to open all windows and doors to ventilate fumes.

CAUTION: DO NOT INHALE TOXIC FUMES!!

- *Do not touch the painted surface when burning for the first time as the paint will soften as it cures further.*
- *The painted surface could mark if not fully cured.*
- *As the woodburner cools, the paint will harden and should have even colouring.*
- *If not, burn the Little Honey again, on high, until even colouring and no further fuming.*

WHEN LIGHTING THE FIRE:

- ✓ Use Fine Dry kindling or a firelighter
- ✓ Have both air vents open (knobs out) and the "T" shaped lever (Double burner plate) pulled out
- ✓ Leave the door slightly ajar for a few minutes

DO NOT LEAVE UNATTENDED WHILE DOOR IS OPEN!!

- Push "T" shaped lever in when the fire is well alight
- Adjust air vents as required. Out = HOTTER
- Before opening the door, open both air vents & pull out "T" lever. Always use the tool provided to pull/push the "T" lever when hot.
- To put fire out – push both air vents in completely.
